MAIN STREET CONSTRUCTION

by the DOT - Highway Paving of NY Route 5
I-290 to Williamsville EVL
Town of Amherst and village of Williamsville
Erie County

Project Overview and Proposed Sequence of Operations

New York State Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the Village of Williamsville, will begin a construction project on Route 5, Main Street, from Interstate 290 to Farber Lane beginning Monday June 4, 2018. The project will include drainage inlet repairs, curb "bump outs" in the parking areas, pedestrian (Hawk Signal) crossing at the library, new sidewalks and exposed aggregate snow storage areas between Reist Street and Evans Street, milling and resurfacing of Main Street between I-290 and Farber Lane, new road signs and improvements to the ADA crosswalk ramps at the intersections with reclaimed brick paver accents.

There will be no lane closures during the morning and afternoon rush hours (6:00 AM – 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM – 6:00 PM) Monday through Friday. Outside of the restricted times, you may encounter single lane closures in both directions. The contractor may be working in the parking lanes at any time so residents may experience restrictions in these areas. It will be the goal to minimize the impact of parking restrictions. No Parking signs and cones will be placed the evening prior to the planned work. Amherst police will strictly enforce the no parking areas. Please obey these signs to avoid conflict and possible tickets.

The milling (removal of the surface layer of the asphalt) and paving will take place during the overnight hours for reasons of safety and in order to minimize the impact to commuter traffic and to achieve a quality product

The contractor will work around the major village festivals in an attempt to alleviate the impact to traffic and patrons. This is a construction project so please be aware the surrounding area and proceed with caution.

With cooperation of the weather and understanding of the residents, we will complete the project by the end of October 2018.

National Fuel will have a contractor on site beginning 6/4/18. They will work on their facilities on the north side of Main Street, beginning at Reist Street and progress towards Mill Street. They will inform the businesses and residents, daily, on what impacts they will have to their service.

Phase 1 Village Square to Mill Street on South Side

Start 6/4/18

End 6/29/18*

Curb, sidewalk, snow storage, ADA ramps, foundations for HAWK Signal, drainage structure installations and rehabs.

HAWK signal pole delivery expected last week of July.

*Progress of work will depend upon the on-time delivery of the granite curbs. Contractor will work outside the "festival areas" as necessary.

The goal is to complete S. Cayuga to Mill by 6/29.

Phase 2 I-290 to Village Square South and North Sides

Start 7/9/18

End 7/23/18

Complete all drainage rehabs, ADA ramps, curbs and sidewalks

Phase 3 Mill Street – East Village Line South and North Sides

Start 7/24/18

End 8/7/18

Complete all drainage rehabs, ADA ramps, curbs and sidewalks

Phase 4 Reist Street to Mill Street North Side

Start 7/30/18

End 8/15/18

Curb, sidewalk, snow storage, ADA ramps, foundations for HAWK Signal, drainage structure installations and rehabs.

*The contractor will concentrate on the completion of the Cayuga to Mill section and will avoid working in this area on Thursdays after 3:30 PM to avoid the Thursday music festivals.

Phase 5 Milling and Paving I-290 to Williamsville South High School

(NIGHT WORK)

Start 9/7/18

End 9/30/18

Mill existing roadway surface, adjust manholes and water valve boxes in road to proposed elevation, power company, gas company and phone company to adjust their manholes and valve boxes.

Pave new asphalt surface and temporary striping.

Phase 6 Final Road Striping and new sign installation

Start 10/1/18

End 10/31/18

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
